*In second grade, we use a behavior system that involves students maintaining a bank account. We use this method to also teach money all year long. During the week, students may have their accounts credited and debited for various reasons. Each Friday, the students can shop at the class store for various items and purchase them out of funds from their account.

In the fall, we will need various small items donated to stock the store. The items can be new or gently used. Some examples of items donated in the past have included pencils, erasers, dollar stores items, books, and small stuffed animals. We also have tickets that can be purchased in the store such as *'sit at the teacher's desk'* for the day, *'draw on the white board'*, and *'eat lunch in the classroom with a friend'*. Over the summer, if you could set aside some items that we could use in the class store next year, we would appreciate it!
