## Principals Report

### Michele Morgan, Academie Da Vinci School Principal

- Run for the Arts had 88 participants and raised over \$2,000
- Book Fair – tomorrow is the last night to stop by.
- In case of Emergency: Cameras have been installed (waiting on a few more to arrive) and 3 more speakers have been added.
- Garden: Total project estimate \$10-15,000
  - Gifted Program has been measuring and creating designs
  - Need a structural engineer to assist with this project.
- Sound System Phase 2
  - Up to \$13,000 estimate for phase 2
  - Need a Lavalier Mic System – Wishlist is to have 10 mics with accessories.
  - \$150 per mic (not including the accessories needed to run with the mic.
  - Goal is to support any ADV show with all equipment needed.
- Supporting All Students
  - Fundraising – money raised to support the needs of the students and school
  - Discussed which projects the PTA can support and which projects the school has to support
  - PTA can't help with building/structure but can support things that support the children (Garden, Dance Flooring, Basketball/tennis court flooring, covering the area between the buildings, new curriculum)
  - There are by laws that Mrs. Morgan and Carrie have reviewed that states what the PTA can and can't support the school with by fundraisers.
- School Mental Health Plan
  - We have a Peer Mediation Team
  - Consists of 8 8<sup>th</sup> graders who went through a 14-week program to be on the Team
  - Today was the 1<sup>st</sup> time working with students and worked with 5<sup>th</sup> graders.
  - They will continue to work with students for the remainder of the school year.

-Process to select 7<sup>th</sup> graders to prepare them to be next years team will begin next month.
